

“Privacy and security policies”

Welcome to the website of Academia Historica. In an effort to ensure your security in using the services and information provided by the Website, we would like to introduce to you the Website's privacy and information security policies. Please carefully read the following articles, which are aimed at protecting your interests.

I. Privacy policy

- Scope of policy

This policy applies to the handling and use of personal information collected when you use the services offered by the Website. This policy is not applicable to websites of other government agencies or non-government agencies that can be accessed via hyperlinks provided by the Website. Other websites accessed via the hyper links on the Website are governed by their own specific privacy protection and information security policies. For more information, please see the relevant statements on each website.

- Collection, handling, and use of information

1. When you browse or download files from the Website, the Website will not collect any personal information.
2. To use the Website's online services, such as Contact Us, Online Resources, Online Reservation, you will need to furnish accurate personal information, including your full name, address, telephone number, and email address. If you provide mistaken or untrue information, the Website reserves the right to turn down your application and refuse service.

3. The Website will log users' IP addresses, access times, and the frequency with which various information is accessed.
4. For the purposes of internal administration, the Website will use information on the browsing and access activities of users to analyze the total volume of website traffic and network activity. This information is important to our efforts to improve service quality.
5. The Website uses a third-party analytics service provider (currently Google Analytics) to analyze information in cookies. Our third-party analytics service provider will not use cookies to obtain personal information.
6. In accordance with the Personal Information Protection Act and related legislation, your personal information that is collected by the Website will not be sold or leased to other groups, individuals, or private entities, nor will such information be exchanged with them, except under the following circumstances: (1) a law enforcement agency needs it for the purposes of a lawful investigation; or (2) a public authority needs the information for the purposes of an investigation or to carry out its duties.
7. Some pages on the Website may include content from third-party websites, including youtube.com and facebook.com. A third-party website might use a related technology to provide you with personalized content, so you should refer to the third-party website's privacy policy for more information.
8. Academia Historica must be notified if a user intends to quote any information from any of the pages of the Website. Meanwhile, the source of any information used must be cited. If you intend to use a photograph from the Website, in addition to requirements set out above, we also ask that you take note of the photographed person's right of publicity and legal requirements regarding the protection of personal information.

- Protection of personal information

The computers hosting this website are all equipped with firewalls, anti-virus systems and other necessary data security equipment and measures. Stringent protection measures have been adopted to secure this website and the personal information of visitors, and only authorized personnel may access visitors' personal information.

- Revisions to privacy policy

The Website's privacy policy is subject to revision at any time. Any revisions to the policy will be posted on the Website.

II. Information security policy

The Website prohibits unauthorized persons from taking any action that would compromise the confidentiality, integrity, or usability of the Website. Violators will be dealt with according to the law. The Website has put in place the following security measures to ensure secure and uninterrupted operation of the Website:

1. The Website has installed a firewall to limit access to designated ports, thereby preventing illegal intrusion. This prevents illegal use of the Website, and also protects the interests of users.
2. Measures have been taken to detect network messages and monitor network traffic, and to block any malicious activity.

3. Anti-virus software has been installed to provide users with a secure environment for browsing our webpages.
4. Software is used to detect any Website vulnerabilities. It periodically scans the network system for vulnerabilities and takes appropriate measures to correct them.
5. Backup operations are carried out on a regular basis. All of the information on the Website is saved to a backup system.
